# Tasting Notes

## Reds

**Belle Glos, Clark & Telephone, Pinot Noir, Santa Maria Valley, CA**  
The color is deep scarlet-red with lush aromas of blackberry, bramble, nutmeg and hint of caramel. The wine is fresh and exuberant in the mouth with sumptuous strawberry jam, ripe black cherry, cranberry and warm gingerbread.

**Ken Wright Cellars, Savoya Vineyard, Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley OR** - The Ken Wright Savoya Vineyard Pinot Noir begins as floral and spice focused Aromas. On the palate, black cherry, cranberry, pomegranate with earthy cola and saddle leather notes.

**Evening Land La Source, Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley OR** - The La Source Pinot Noir comes from vines at the very top of Seven Spring Vineyard. Aromatic, with an elegant blend of mountain berries, just ripe cherries, and a refreshing minerality, this estate grown fruit is farmed organically and biodynamically.

**L' Ecole 2014, Merlot, Columbia Valley** - Layered with enticing aromas of blackberry, violet, and mint, this full-bodied Merlot shows balanced layers of huckleberry, plum and baking spice on a seamless finish of fine grained tannin.

**Wente Sandstone, Merlot, Livermore Valley, CA** - Up front fragrances of spiced cherry with a focus on dark fruit such as blueberry or boysenberry. A smooth mouthfeel, bright acidity and inviting tannins are balanced by a clean and dry finish.

**Alexander Valley, Cabernet Franc Sonoma County, CA** - Rich, lush wine with earthy flavors of plum, black cherry, vanilla and blueberry. Nicely balanced, great texture without the tannins. 100% Cabernet Franc aged in French oak barrels.

**Daou, Cabernet Sauvignon, Paso Robles, CA** - Blackberry, cassis, plum and currant aromas greet the nose. Firm, fine tannins provide ample backbone for the layers of boysenberry, black cherry, licorice and dried herbs.

**Boomtown, Cabernet Sauvignon, Columbia Valley, WA** - Refined, yet rugged; the wine offers wonderful cherry fruit and balancing acid while giving you the rustic complexity of freshly crushed herbs.

**Goldschmidt Katherine, Cabernet Sauvignon, CA** - Rich and robust aromas of blackberry, black cherry, spice and licorice. Secondary aromas of red tobacco and creamy vanilla. Black currant, cherry, and raspberry flavors are accented with sage and dark chocolate. Smooth, soft, and supple finish.

**Round Pond Kith & Kin, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa, CA** - Kith & Kin, Old English for "Friends & Family." Red fruit driven, the supple entry teases with bright notes of fresh cherry and licorice immediately lead into darker, fleshier notes.

**Mad Hatter, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa, CA** - Gorgeously deep ruby/purple color, a sweet kiss of licorice, black currants, black cherries, camphor and incense. This wine is fragrant, with supple tannins, an opulent lushness and a total hedonistic and intellectual turn on.

**CrossBarn by Paul Hobbs, Cabernet Sauvignon 2013, Napa Valley CA** - Dark crimson in color, our Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon exudes enticing aromas of cassis, boysenberry, lavender, sage, cedar, and tobacco leaf. A tantalizing palate offers a medley of peak-ripe, plums, wild berries, thyme, clove and vanillin. Creamy fine grain tannins from front to finish. Rich, savory flavors that coat the mouth entirely and continuously. Dense and mouthwateringly juicy. 93 points Robert Parker wine advocate.

**Vineyard 29, CRU, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa, CA** - Expressive aromas of blackberry, mountain sage, rose petal and sandalwood. Palate abounds with expansive layers of brambly black fruit, touch of red cassis and dusty cocoa powder. Stunning in mouth feel, this richly textured wine delivers velvety, palate coating richness that carries through an endless finish.

**Cuvelier Los Andes, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina** - Vibrant penetrating aromas of blackberry, black cherry, bitter chocolate. Dense and seamless but youthful and light on its feet. Finishes with firm ripe tannins. 90 points Stephen Tanzer Vinous 5/2016.

# Tasting Notes

**Caymus, Malbec, Red Schooner Voyage 5 Wine of the World, Napa, CA** - This Malbec is made from grapes grown in the Andes Mountains, shipped chilled to Napa Valley and produced with the same techniques as Caymus Cabernet. Falling outside standard labeling rules, it does not include a vintage date but is known by the voyage from which it was produced (Voyage 5 is the 2014 vintage). Offering scents of ripe plums and cherries, this wine is powerful and supple, with flavors of French oak and soft tannins.

**Chappellet Mountain Cuvee Proprietor's Blend, Napa Valley, CA** - Blended from traditional Bordeaux varietals, elegant aromas of spicy red fruit, black cherry, sage clove and cocoa powder. Palate is silky and balanced, with a plush mouth coating texture that makes the wine immediately approachable and delicious.

**Kuleto India Ink Red, Red Blend** - The 2014 India Ink is driven by ripe dark fruit aromas and delicate toasty oak. The palate is rich, creamy, and mouth-coating with just enough tannin to perfectly compliment any grilled meat or vegetable.

**Ridge, East Bench Zinfandel 2016, Sonoma County, CA** - Blackberry, cocoa licorice on the nose. Full-bodied palate with fig and plum fruit, chalky tannins, mineral and chaparral notes on the finish.

**Ridge, Raso Robles Zinfandel 2016, Paso Robles, CA** - Deep garnet color. Black cherry fruit aromas and scented barrel spice. Rich bramble fruit on entry, medium body, integrated tannins, and lively acidity, a long opulent finish.

**Sbragia Gino' Zinfandel, Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma County, CA** - Blending different vineyards to produce a wine with classic Dry Creek Valley character, Gino's Zinfandel represents a traditional field blend of Zinfandel, Carignan, Petite Sirah and other varieties. Full of lush red ripe fruit. It has a core of sweet red currant and strawberry with a bright finish. 90 points Robert Parker Wine Advocate 12/2014.

**Dow's Port 10 Year, Douro Valley, Portugal** - Soft and rich palate. Baker apricot, dried mango, cherry tart flavors with almond overtones. 90 points Wine Spectator.

**Straccali Chianti, Classico Tuscany, Italy** - Bright, youthful aromas of ripe red fruit, Velvety and refreshing finish.

**Fontanafredda, Barolo Serralunga, d' Alba Piedmont, Italy** - Garnet red with ruby highlights taking on a slightly orange tone over time. Intense nose with overtones of vanilla, spices, withered roses and underbrush. Dry full body, with velvety texture and great balance.

**Reserve de la Comtesse, Bordeaux** - The nose is succulent and fleshy with ripe black plum and cassia. The palate starts with the same depth of flavor, lots of prunes and black cherry enriched by rounded tannins. The finish is fresher still black fruited with an attractive black pepper spiciness.

## Whites

**Bartenura Moscato, Italy** - Crisp and sweet on the palate with lingering pear, tangerine, nectar and melon flavors for a refreshing finish.

**Ponzi, Pinot Gris, Willamette Valley, OR** - Aromas of guava, white tea, with an accent of wintergreen or spruce needle precede the textured palate laced with ginger spice, white pepper and peach. The finish is fresh and bright leaving a trail of lime zest and poached pear.

**Joel Gott, Pinot Gris, Willamette Valley, OR** - White peach aromas with floral notes. Balanced, bright acidity with lemon citrus flavor and long finish.

**Frank Family Vineyards, Chardonnay, Napa Valley, CA** - The 2015 Chardonnay has a pale-yellow straw color. Aromas of white flowers, stone fruit, lemon zest and a hint of vanilla, lead to a rich and enveloping palate of lychee fruit and toasted almonds, with bright, mouth-watering acidity.

## Whites

**Artesa, Chardonnay, Carneros, CA** - Juicy green apples, pineapple, lemon nose. Peppery, intricate, medium finish and chewy tannins.

**Ferrari - Carano, Chardonnay, Sonoma County, CA** - Aromas of graham cracker quince, lemons perfectly balanced by flavors of Meyer lemon, pear and butter cream with a toasty vanilla finish.

**Patz & Hall, Chardonnay, Sonoma Coast, CA** - Beautifully complex with aromas and flavors of pineapple, guava, honeydew and lime zest. Plush and mouth filling, flowing to a long—layered finish. 91 points Excellent Highly Recommended Wine Enthusiast 6/2016.

**Dr. Loosen, Dr. L Riesling, Mosel, Germany** - Refreshing and fruity, with a fine mineral edge that is typical of the region.

**Rombauer, Sauvignon Blanc, Napa Valley, CA** - Exudes aromas and flavors of ripe lime and lemon, grapefruit, pear and nectarine. Palate is fresh and enticing, balanced yet lively acidity lingers.

**Brancott, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand** - Sweet ripe fruit characters with a mix of citrus, floral, pear tropical fruit. Lush pink grapefruit, sweet fruit flavors and crisp acidity.

## Rose'

**Jean - Luc Colombo Cape Rose, Provence, France** - Subtle flavors, of peach, rose petal, watermelon and tropical fruit. Dry & round, flavors of fresh berries.

## Sparkling

**Kenwood Yulupa, Brut, CA** - Ripe peaches, juicy pear, and citrus aromas. Light, refreshing and crisp fruit.

**Roederer Estate, Brut, Anderson Valley Sonoma, CA** - A voluptuous, expressive sparkler, with floral apple, brioche and cinnamon spice aromas that lead to rich vibrant flavors that finish on a luxurious note. #25 of 2017 Top 100 Wine Spectator.
